Entry Form

The MAA Community Relations Awards Program is designed to recognize companies in the aggregate industry whose community involvement and support activities enhance the public's perception of the aggregates industry and the image of the individual company.

Any active MAA member (Producer or Associate) is eligible for the award.

The Community Relations Program Award applications will be judged by the MAA Public Relations Committee on the following six criteria.

Note: To assist with the application process a few examples of various items that fall under each heading are noted for reference. Please feel free to expand or modify any of the noted examples to fit your program.

Community Participation/Outreach/Special Events

- Attendance and participation at meetings with local residents
- o Community run/walk events
- Special events you host at your location or nearby location

Donations and service

- Material to improve local parks, ballfields, roadways, etc.
- Assistance in building/improving local parks, homes, charity events
- Land donated to local communities/non-profit groups

Local and state government involvement

- Hosting legislative visits
- Presenting at state and local meetings

Communications

- News bulletins to community members about mining updates/news
- Notices send to residents about various activities that are taking place at the mine (i.e., blasts, etc)

Educational outreach

- MiRocksRock box presentation to schools
- Provide opportunity for schools to visit your operation
- Online learning tools and guides

Media relations

- Social media posts (Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, etc)
- Letters to local news papers
- o Radio or TV interviews that highlight your company's community impacts
